Objects

The objects of the CCLAA are:

- (1) to create a link between former CCLEF Scholars across the Commonwealth in a spirit of friendship;
- (2) for members to act, if they are able, as mentors to girls of secondary school age who are currently receiving sponsorship and to offer support, guidance and encouragement if they seek help;
- (3) for members to encourage the sharing of knowledge with others in similar circumstances and possibly help with furthering career opportunities or life experiences;
- (4) for members to write an occasional piece for a CCLAA newsletter. This may be about their experiences since leaving school or an item of general interest;
- (5) for members to tell former scholars about the CCLAA and encourage their participation;
- (6) for members to maintain contact with the CCLAA Coordinator, via e-mail where this is possible – at ccl.aa@btinternet.com.

Costs and Background

The costs of administering the CCLAA will be met by The Commonwealth Countries' League, an organisation founded in 1925 to promote equality of liberties, status and opportunities between men and women. The League links together women's organisations and individuals throughout the Commonwealth. It is a pan-Commonwealth non-governmental organisation and runs a programme of informative talks, social functions and fundraising events. The annual Commonwealth Fair, organised by the CCL in association with the wives of the High Commissioners in London, provides much of the funding for the Education Fund.

The Alumnae Coordinator, on behalf of the Association, will have the power to refuse or amend articles submitted for publication and to disassociate the Association from any activity that may bring its objects into question or disrepute.
